

**TOWN OF WHITE LAKE
STORM DEBRIS REMOVAL**

**HURRICANE FLORENCE
(Second Posting)**

The Town of White Lake is accepting bids for removal and transport of storm debris to Hurricane Florence. Vegetative storm debris, limbs and leaves will be collected at the edge of street easement. Debris is to be hauled to and weighed in at the Bladen County Landfill scales before proceeding to the designated Bladen County temporary vegetative debris site where debris will be deposited.

A weight ticket will be provided by the operator of the Bladen County Landfill scales for each load of debris verifying the weight of each load hauled to the site. All bids should reflect the price per ton per round trip, approximately eighteen (18) miles round trip. An assigned monitor provided by the Town of White Lake will work with the contractor. The monitor will coordinate all questions and issues between the contractor and the Town of White Lake and will be responsible for maintaining all weight tickets and forms required by FEMA identifying where the debris came from.

All bids shall comply with the following guidelines:

- Price per ton.
- Returned in a sealed envelope to Brenda Clark, Administrative Services Director, Town of White Lake no later than 5:00 p.m., Friday, November 09, 2018.
- Provide a Certificate of Insurance.
- Provide a list of all equipment and personnel assigned to the project.
- Every effort to work with Historically Underutilized Businesses in the State of North Carolina for Hurricane Florence must be undertaken. Provide the methods you employ to provide proactive outreach for minority, female, veteran-owned firms.

Bid opening, pending the required number of three (3) bids received, will be held at 9:00 a.m. on Monday, November 12, 2018 in the conference room at the White Lake Municipal Building. This notice shall be posted for a minimum of seven (7) days.
